

The Health Information Security and Privacy Collaborative Role Based Access Group for Ohio held a brief meeting this morning (10/26/2007) and agreed to the principles in the attached PowerPoint and abstract (previously sent also).

The guiding principles would be to adapt and adopt the Minnesota framework for Ohio and to begin to fill in the specifics. The recommendation is to classify healthcare workers into the ASTM roles for future use in additional granularity, but to group them into 3 primary categories (1) Healthcare Provider (2) Prescriber (3) Administrative staff. The use of best practice security measures will prevail with full HIPAA log tables for each view and update of information.

The group also recommends a common sense approach that will facilitate access to information at the point of care.

The group agreed to use the attached PowerPoint and abstract with the Governor's Steering committee as the basis for discussion.
